National Jr. Honor Society is collecting coins for "We Create Change". Their focus is Economic Empowerment, purchasing dairy goats for impoverished areas of Kenya. Each goat costs \$50 and we're asking that each of our 24 homeroom classes raise enough money for one goat, about \$2 per student. Last year, our goal was 21 goats but we raised enough money to buy 61 goats! A healthy goat can produce up to 16 cups of milk a day. This milk can be used to sell, trade or feed a family. With financial planning assistance, a goat can lift a family out of poverty.
